<b>Description:</b>	
New Zealand School of Education offers a number of scholarships each year based on financial need and/or academic merit.	
In 2018 applications are invited for the following:	
<p style="text-align: center;">One scholarship to the value of \$5000 based on Academic Merit or Financial Need Up to ten scholarships each valued between \$500 to \$1000 based on Academic Merit and/or Financial Need</p>	
<b>Conditions:</b>	
1.	A NZSE scholarship may not be used in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
2.	Applicants must be available for an interview with the NZSE Scholarship Panel.
3.	The decision of the NZSE Scholarship Panel is final.
4.	Successful applicants will be required to pass their courses with a “B” average and must maintain contact with Student Support Services at NZSE to continue to receive scholarship payments.

1.	A copy of ID, proof of NZ citizenship/residency (NZ Birth Certificate, Passport or overseas Passport with NZ Residency).	
2.	Evidence of fulltime enrolment in a fee paying programme of one or more years at the New Zealand School of Education (NZSE).	
3.	Certified copy of Academic Transcripts (Secondary and/or Tertiary).	
4.	Evidence of financial need for scholarships based on financial need only. This should include personal bank statements for the previous three months that show your current financial circumstances and a personal statement clearly demonstrating financial need (this could include transport costs, medical conditions preventing the applicant from working part time, family and personal circumstances and the current balance of your student loan).	
5.	A current Curriculum Vitae including a brief history of your educational achievements, work experience and skills.	
6.	A minimum of one reference specifically supporting your application. This must be from an employer, lecturer, teacher or other respected person (school principal, or community leader) who can be contacted by the selection panel. The referee should highlight reasons why the applicant is a good candidate for the scholarship. This could include: any adversity the student has overcome, a particular talent in areas related to the programme of study that the scholarship funds, a clear intent to pursue a career related to the programme of study, and outstanding leadership or contributions to the community.	
7.	A supporting letter in which you address how you meet the criteria for the scholarship. The letter should include key achievements to date, career goals, your contribution to NZSE and to your community.
